Friendship – The Good Samaritan

God's Masterpiece can be used as standalone activities or as a full night programme to help you make the most out of these resources. These templates will provide you with a rough plan for a full night session for each piece of the God's Masterpiece resource to be enjoyed or amended as needed for each company's needs. All the necessary resources and full instructions for each activity will be available on the resource area.



Icebreaker: Match the duos

This quick game encourages conversation and interactions between young people to ask each other questions to find out who their character is, and to then match up with the character that is associated with them: e.g. Buzz and Woody, Anna and Elsa etc...



Bible Passage: Luke 10:25-37

Read the passage together with the young people. Read the story again and pick young people to act it out and point out where the people in the story were friendly or not, and what would they do in that situation.

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Activity: What makes a good friend?

This activity is a good opportunity to find out what the young people perceive as a good friend and will allow for conversations and discussion on what make a good friend and how we can be a good friend to others.



Game: Build a bridge

The aim of this game is teamwork and communication. These skills, kindness and friendship go hand in hand. If the team do not work well together, the bridge will collapse.



Craft: Collaborative Colouring – (A resource downloaded from twinkl.com) This craft will allow young people to work together to make an even bigger picture promote friendship and kindness amongst the young people.
