The World Around Us – The creation story

God's Masterpiece can be used as standalone activities or as a full night programme to help you make the most out of these resources. These templates will provide you with a rough plan for a full night session for each piece of the God's Masterpiece resource to be enjoyed or amended as needed for each company's needs. All the necessary resources and full instructions for each activity will be available on the resource area.



Bible passage and activity: Genesis 1 (The creation story)

Using the interactive bible story resource tell the story of creation and then using the template, draw what God created each day in each box. What are the young people's favourite things God has made? Give them a blank page and ask them what would they make each day if they were able to make the world?



Baking: Crepes

Teach the young people that different foods that we enjoy comes from various places, such as crepes come from France. For Anchors, provide them with pre-made crepes and decorations to decorate them with and talk about how food can be linked back to God's creation. This also allows an opportunity to learn about French culture and the similarities and differences between young people at home and abroad.



Game: Sensory games.

A fun way for young people within your company to experience what it is like to live in someone else's shoes for a couple of minutes while playing these fun games.



Colouring: All around the world

In BB we wear our uniforms, whereas many children around the world have a traditional outfit that they wear for their country and are proud of. This activity is a good chance to teach the young people in your section about how different countries wear different cultural outfits.
