

REQUIREMENTS FOR A YOUNG PERSON TO GAIN THE PRESIDENT'S BADGE AWARD

- This can be awarded from School Year 11 (Year 1 in Seniors).
- Gain a Core Activity Award (for seniors these are the Bronze, Silver, Gold & Platinum Awards) in the last 12 months or alternatively a young person could have completed The Duke of Edinburgh's Bronze Award to fulfil this element.
- Complete the 'Faith Journey' element.
This element is to be completed through a weekly scripture programme which involves teaching, reading, and discussing the Bible. BBNI provides a scripture course for all companies. **Please note opening devotions does not qualify to cover this element.**
- Complete 2+ Nights Away within last 24 months or 3+ Adventure Days. Adventure days would be something beyond the normal weekly programme such as a trip or an outing.
- Complete 10 hours volunteering in Company/Church or alternatively a young person could have completed Bronze Duke of Edinburgh's Award to fulfil this element.
- Complete President's Badge Building your Skills Course.
This course is delivered by the local Battalion. The young person can attend a course that is being delivered by another Battalion.
- Be an 'Active' member of the Company.
